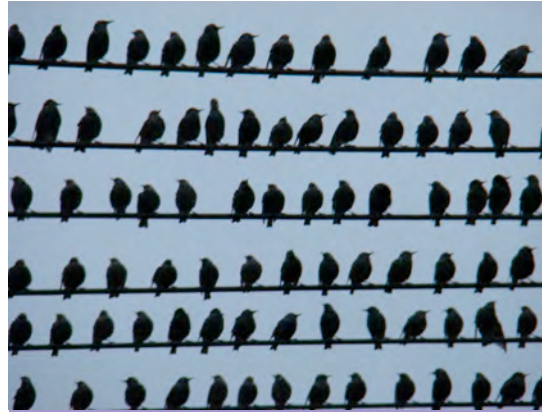


# S.O.S.O.L.O

"The imprisonment of a loved one, is very much like a death, you have to go through the grief and emotions of losing someone" - Iva

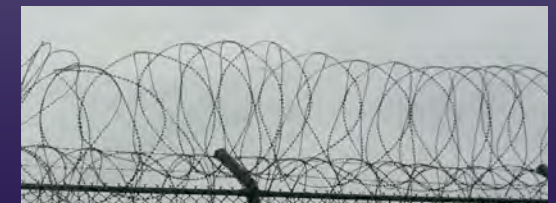
*"I am able to speak freely...while not being judged. Just knowing I am not alone, and have support through SOSOLO, is really important" - Nicki*
